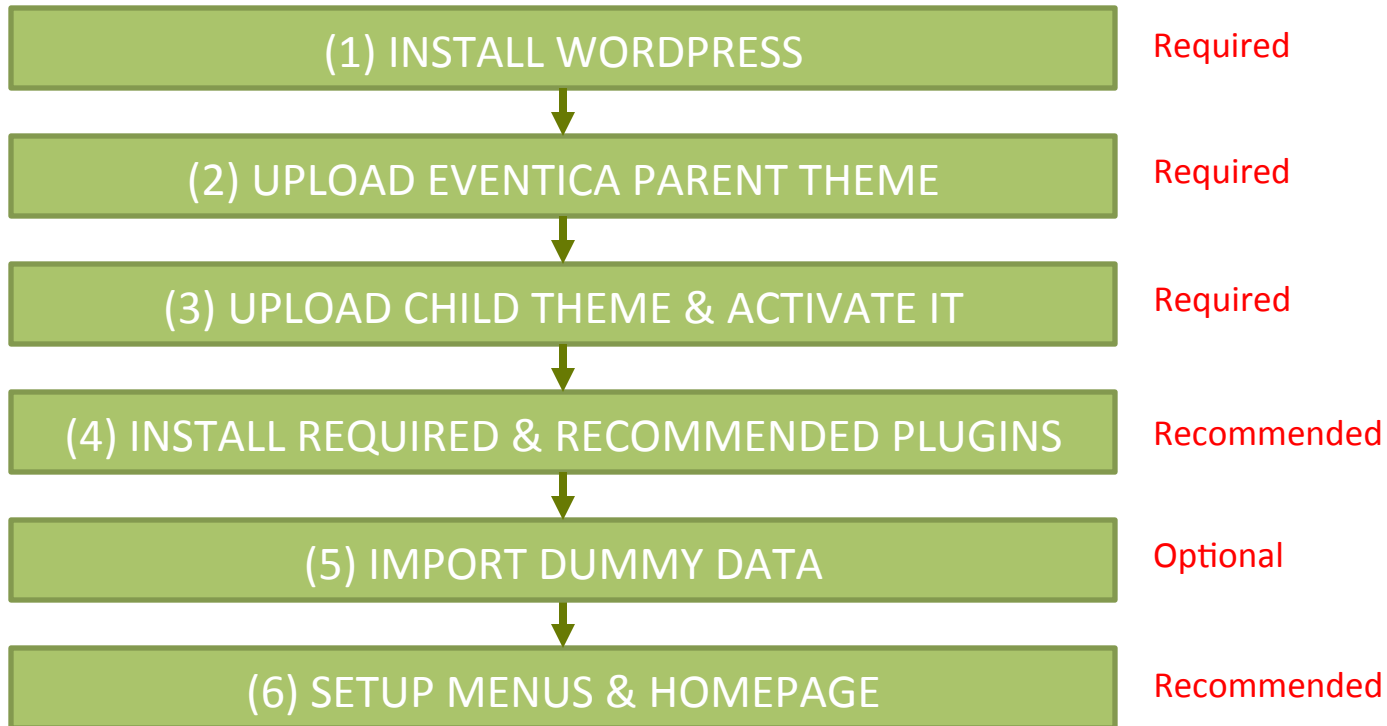

(2&3) Install Eventica WordPress Theme

Go to Appearance > Themes > Install Themes > **Upload**

If you download the Eventica Full Package ZIP from ThemeForest, you can extract this ZIP file first, and you can find theme files under separate folders.

eventica-wp-v1.0.zip (parent theme)

eventica-wp-child-v1.0.zip (child theme)

Go to **Appearance > Themes > Add New > Upload**

Upload **both** eventica-wp-v1.0.zip and eventica-wp-child-v1.0.zip

And then activate this theme Eventica-wp (child theme).

If you have a theme in a .zip format, you may install it by uploading it here.

WHAT IS A CHILD THEME AND WHY USE IT?

Child theme builds upon an existing theme, without modifying the original theme, so that if the theme ever gets updated, your modifications to the theme are safe, because you've created a new theme and the update will only change the original files.

With a child theme, you can rebrand our theme with your own name, without modifying our theme!!!

(5) Import Dummy Data

We provide 3 dummy data to replicate our theme demo.

Dummy Data is useful if you want to replicate our theme demo for quick testing. We provide dummy data. You need to activate all recommended plugins before doing this process.

- 03_dummy_mailchimp_form_template.txt

01) IMPORTING DUMMY CONTENT

Login to your WordPress Dashboard, and go to Tools – Import page, click Wordpress, and choose the XML file above to start importing the demo data. You will need working internet connection to download the dummy images.

02) IMPORTING DUMMY WIDGETS

Login to your WordPress Dashboard, and go to Tools – Widget Importer & Exporter page, click Export Widgets, and choose the WIE file above.

03) IMPORTING DUMMY MAILCHIMP FORM TEMPLATE

Login to your WordPress Dashboard, and go to Mailchimp for WP – Forms page, please put the content of the TXT file above to Form mark-up textarea.

(6) Setup Menus & Homepage

SETUP MENUS

Go to **Appearance – Menus** page to setup your menus.

This theme comes with 2 menu locations:

- Header Menu
- Footer Menu

You can create your menu and drag & drop menu elements on the left. Use **“Screen Options”** button at top right to show/hide all menu elements.

If you use our dummy data, you can click Manage Locations and choose dummy menus.
